#### Black Ski Elections Are Coming April 22nd

Are you interested in making a difference in your ski club? Do you have leadership experience? Are you gifted in the area of administration? A Black Ski Executive Committee or Board of Directors position maybe for you!

Elected positions serve 2 years. All Vice Presidents are to have a committee. VPs should appoint an assistant to help coordinate committee activities and attend meeting in the VP's absence. The positions up for election this year are on both the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors and their primary Roles and responsibilities are as follows:

**President** – Presides over General Membership (Body) and Executive Committee meetings. Administers all business of Black Ski as provided for by the bylaws. Coordinates the activities of the VPs. Acts as the liaison between the general membership and the Board of Directors. Serves as a link between the NBS and Black Ski, Inc. Authorizes the disbursement of funds as outlined by the bylaws.

**Secretary** – Writes and prepares all executive committee and general membership meeting minutes. Makes copies of all minutes of previous meetings available to the general membership. Handles any correspondence necessary for the executive committee.

**VP**, **Adult Racing** – Coordinates all racing activities. Establishes racing teams and programs. Promotes and generates enthusiasm for racing among club members.

**VP, Fundraising** – Plans and implements activities and the sale of goods that will assist the club in meeting its financial obligations; researches, negotiates, purchases, inventories, and

maintains club fundraising merchandise.

**VP**, **Hospitality** – Extends greetings and fellowship to all members and guests of the club at all activities and club events. Coordinates club parties and annual picnic.

**VP, Youth** – Promotes activities among youth up to and including 18 years old. Establishes a development program for youth.

**VP** Advance Planning – Coordinates the planning of winter and summer club trips and most club activities. Must enjoy leading a group and work well with people. Specific duties:

**Board Member** – Establishes policies to conduct the business of Black Ski Inc.

There are also Board of Directors positions up for election.

#### Qualifications for Executive Committee positions:

- Two consecutive years of full membership in Black
- At least 18 years of age

#### Qualifications for the Board of Directors:

- Full membership in Black Ski for a minimum of three consecutive years.
- Administrative, business or organizational service/ experience in Black Ski for a minimum of one year.
- At least 18 years of age.
- Is not holding another elected position in Black Ski.

Nominations are now being accepted. Nominations must be submitted in writing to the Election Committee Chairperson, by April 10, 2008. Nominations may be mailed to the Black Ski Post Office Box.



**Rebuilding Together,** formerly Christmas in April, of Washington, DC is a 501(c) (3) tax-exempt non-profit organization. Known in the community since 1983 as Christmas in April of Washington, DC, we underwent a name change in 2001. Although the name changed, we are the same group with the same mission: to assist low-income elderly and disabled homeowners and families with children to continue living in their own homes when they cannot make critical home repairs or accessibility improvements. Additionally, we repair some nonprofit facilities and public schools.

Rebuilding Together of Washington, DC helps those in need through the practice of "neighbors helping neighbors." In the years since the program began, hundreds of volunteer groups have come forward to repair over 2,500 homes and nonprofits in the District of Columbia, helping to raise the spirits of elderly and disabled homeowners and improving their own team spirit. During the last weekend of April each year, more than 3,000 volunteers fan out across the city to make repairs at approximately 100 project sites. The numbers of volunteers who participate and the popularity of the program increases each year.

Most of the work on project sites occurs on weekends throughout April, culminating on Rebuilding Day, a big blitz-like effort during the last weekend of the month. However, if sponsors prefer, groups can work on a special project at another time of the year (see "Custom" Community Service Days).





Effective 9/1/00 Anyone going on a weekend or longer trip must be a club member.

An initial deposit per person is required to confirm your reservation. A non-refundable deposit fee of \$50 will be assessed if cancellation is received after date specified on trip flyer.

#### **PAYMENTS**

The payment schedule outlined on trip flyer must be adhered to unless arrangements are made with the Trip Directors. Failure to receive payment by date specified may cause loss of reservation (see cancellation for non-payment below). Monies received within thirty (30) days of the trip date will only be accepted in the form of a money order, certified check or cashier's check.
