They made a turn off the towpath onto a boardwalk and they could start to hear a constant rumble in the distance near the overlook of the bulk of the Potomac River. Upon arrival, they could see a beautiful waterfall across a gorge.

On the way back, a few youth stopped to pose where the water roars through several chutes across the gorge. With a sharp eye, they saw a blue herrings and a swirling kayaker, looking like a toy boat. They ran and jumped across broken rocks, threw rocks, climbed a steep terrain hills and watched a mule pull the river boat into the narrow channel lock. At the end of the day, they had not been disappointed.



Rebuilding Together, formerly Christmas in April, of Washington, DC is a 501(c) (3) tax-exempt non-profit organization. Known in the community since 1983 as Christmas in April of Washington, DC, we underwent a name change in 2001. Although the name changed, we are the same group with the same mission: to assist low-income elderly and disabled homeowners and families with children to continue living in their own homes when they cannot make critical home repairs or accessibility improvements. Additionally, we repair some nonprofit facilities and public schools.

Rebuilding Together of Washington, DC helps those in need through the practice of "neighbors helping neighbors." In the years since the program began, hundreds of volunteer groups have come forward to repair over 2,500 homes and nonprofits in the District of Columbia, helping to raise the spirits of elderly and disabled homeowners and improving their own team spirit. During the last weekend of April each year, more than 3,000 volunteers fan out across the city to make repairs at approximately 100 project sites. The numbers of volunteers who participate and the popularity of the program increases each year.

Most of the work on project sites occurs on weekends throughout April, culminating on Rebuilding Day, a big blitz-like effort during the last weekend of the month. However, if sponsors prefer, groups can work on a special project at another time of the year (see "Custom" Community Service Days).

Effective 9/1/00 Anyone going on a weekend or longer trip must be a club member.

An initial deposit per person is required to confirm your reservation. A non-refundable deposit fee of \$50 will be assessed if cancellation is received after date specified on trip flyer.

PAYMENTS

The payment schedule outlined on trip flyer must be adhered to unless arrangements are made with the Trip Directors. Failure to receive payment by date specified may cause loss of reservation (see cancellation for non-payment below). Monies received within thirty (30) days of the trip date will only be accepted in the form of a money order, certified check or cashier's check.
